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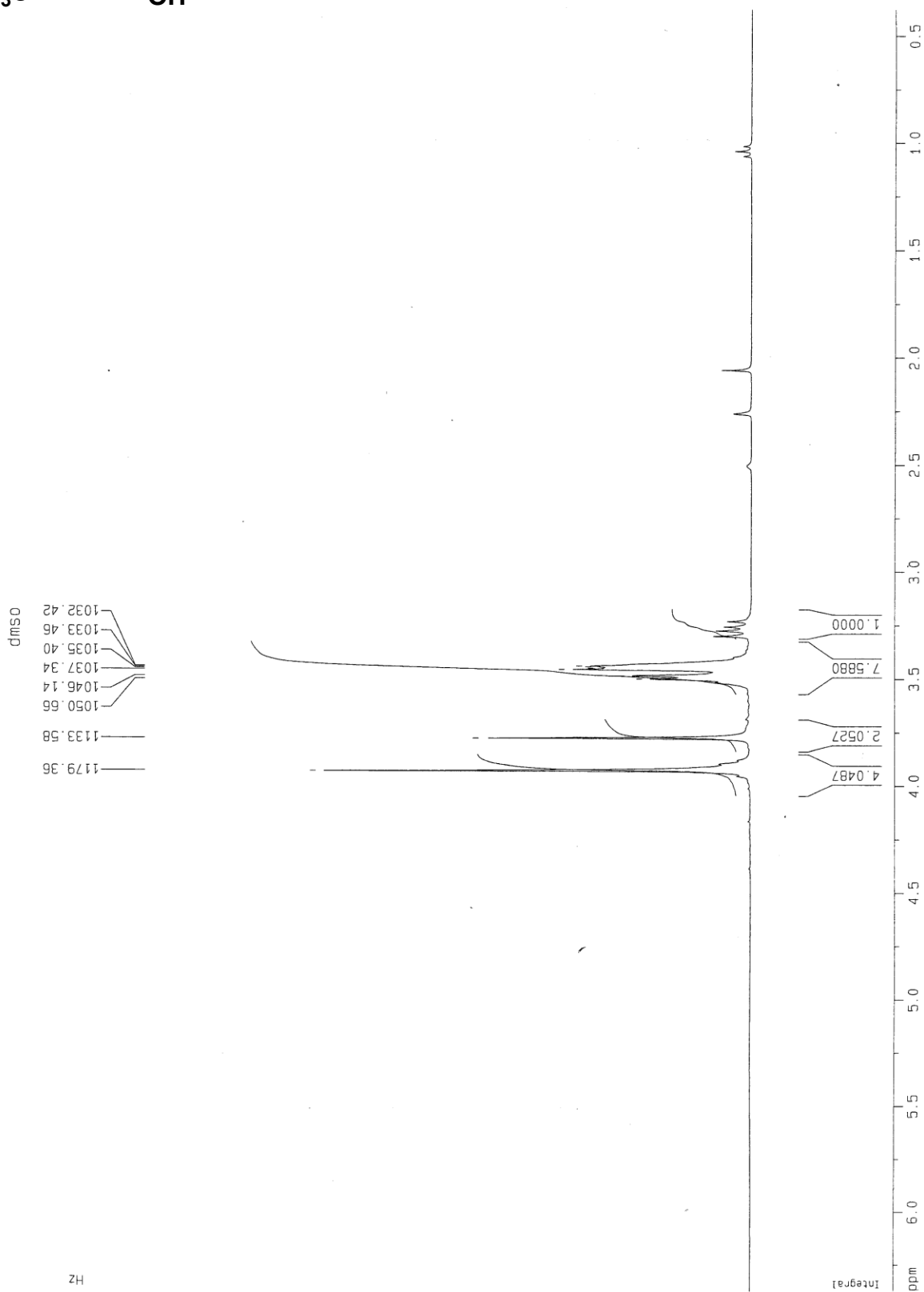
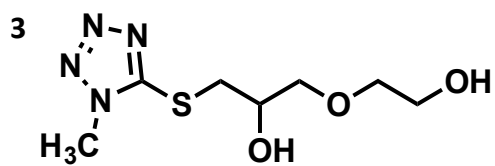
1. ^1H and ^{13}C NMR spectra of crude synthesized compounds.

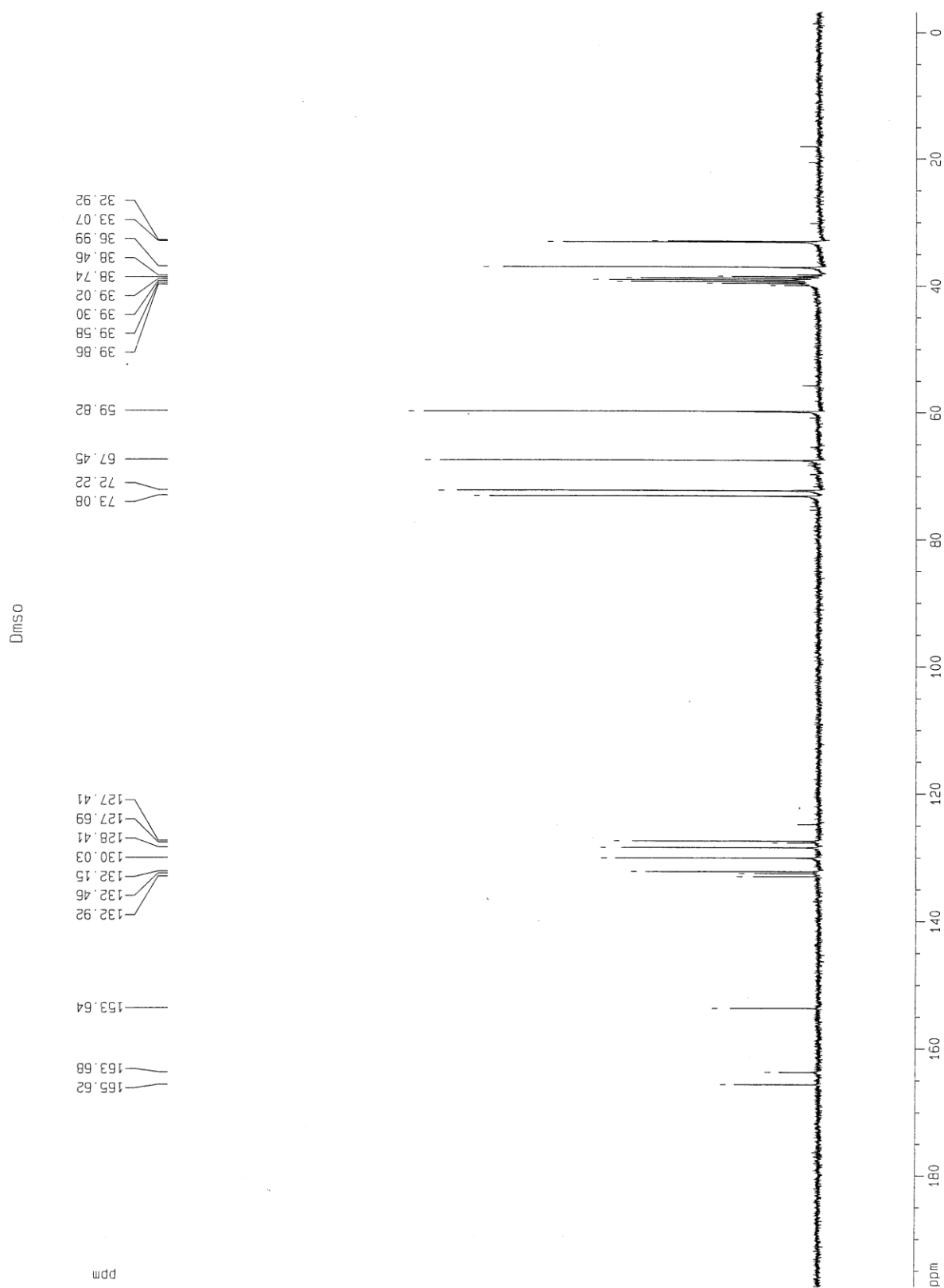
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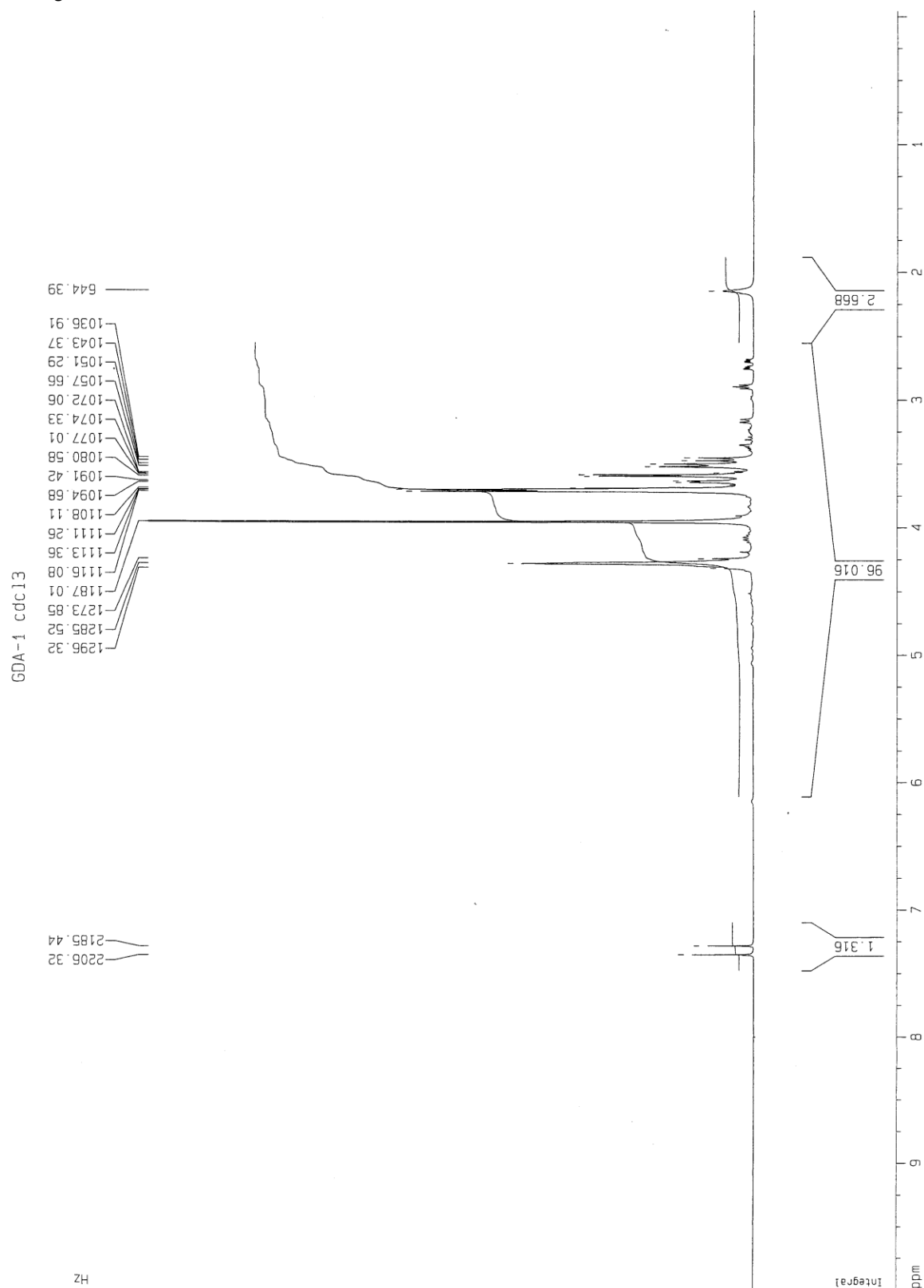
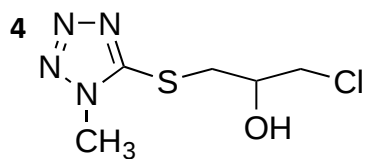
The attached spectra of synthesized compounds refer to samples at the 95% of purity, and sometimes may contain traces of solvents.

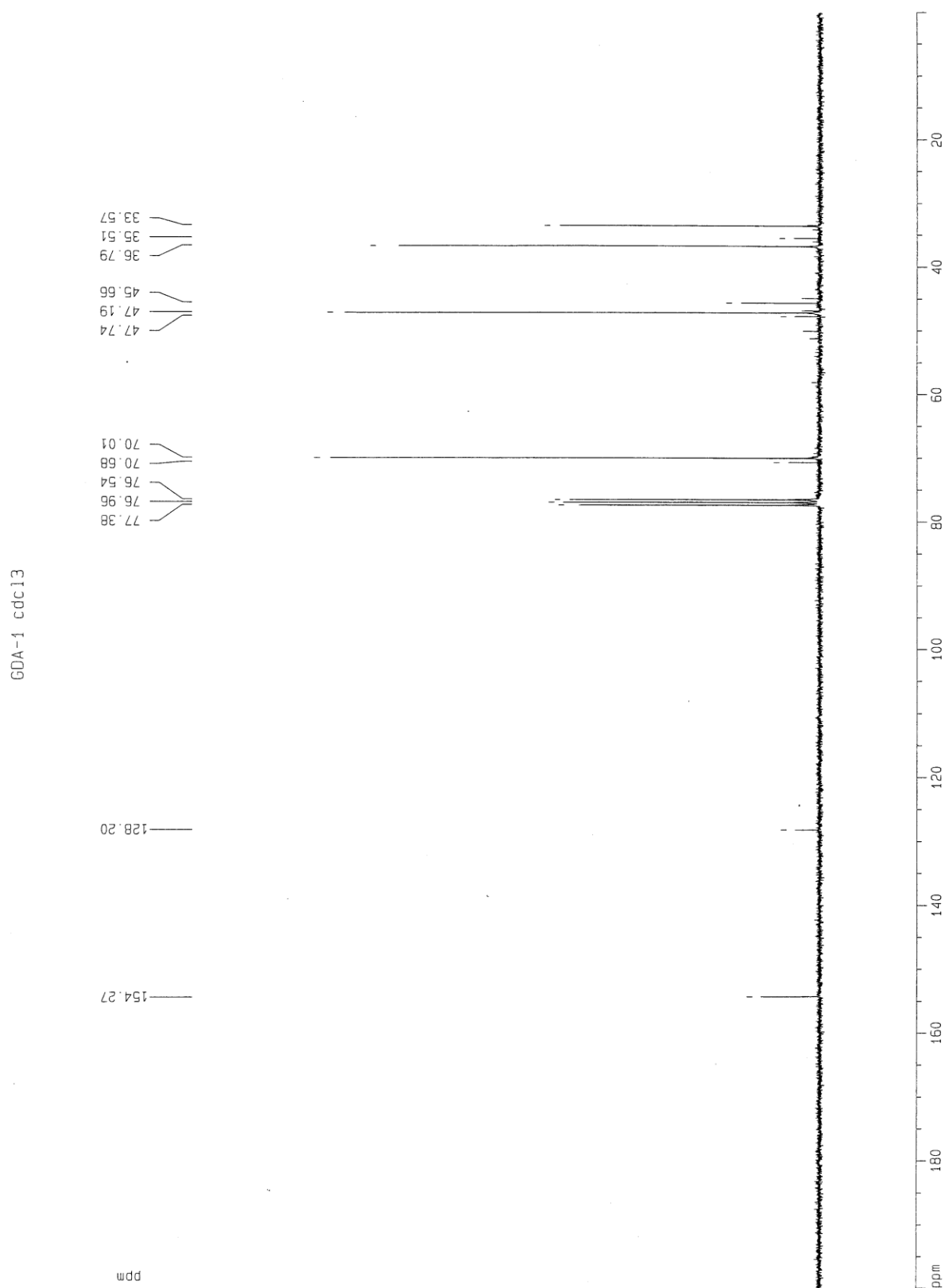
However, we checked that the mentioned impurities not affecting the other signals, in order to assign the structure beyond any reasonable doubt.

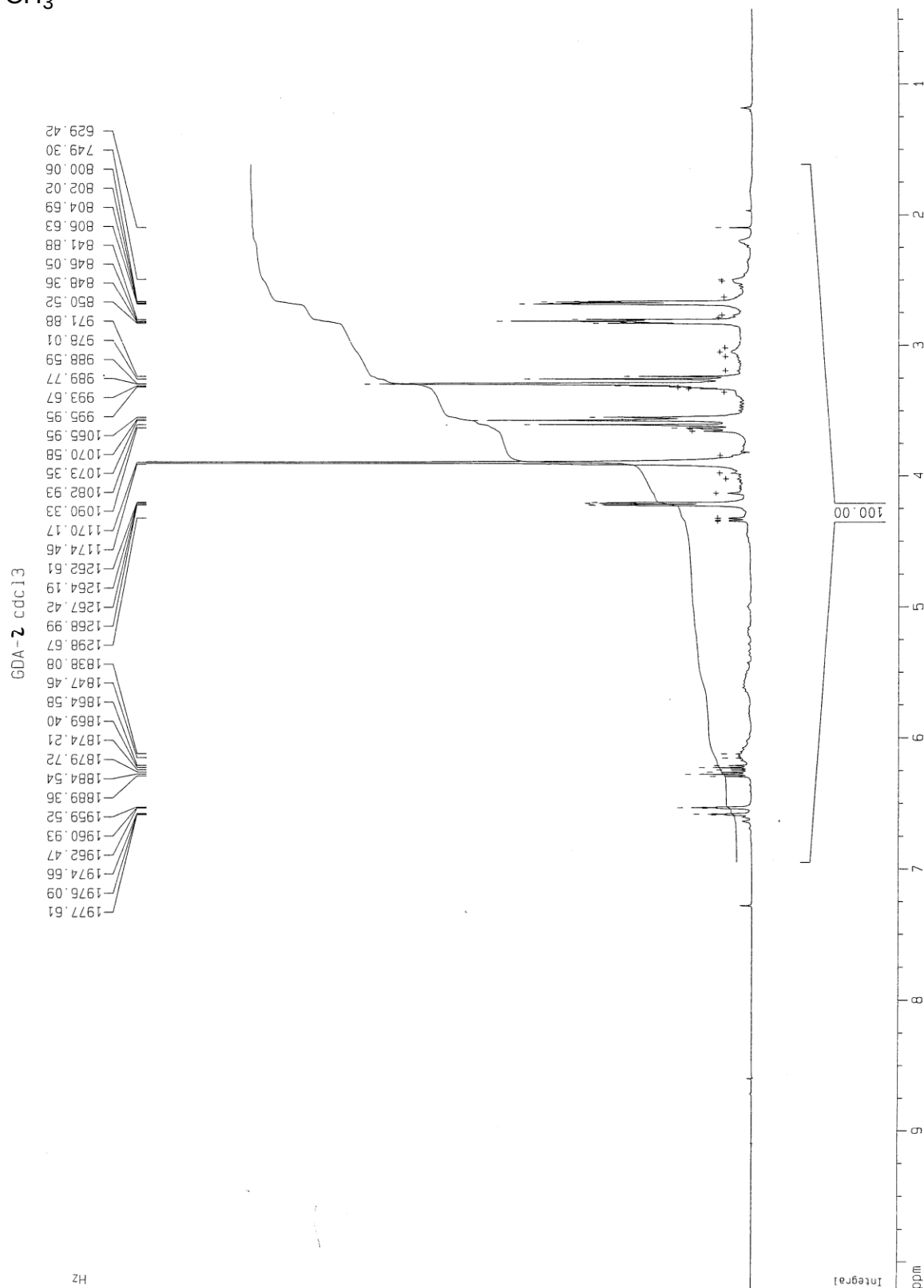
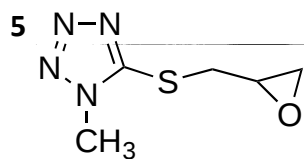
This was done to save precious pure samples for the subsequent synthetic steps and final analyses.

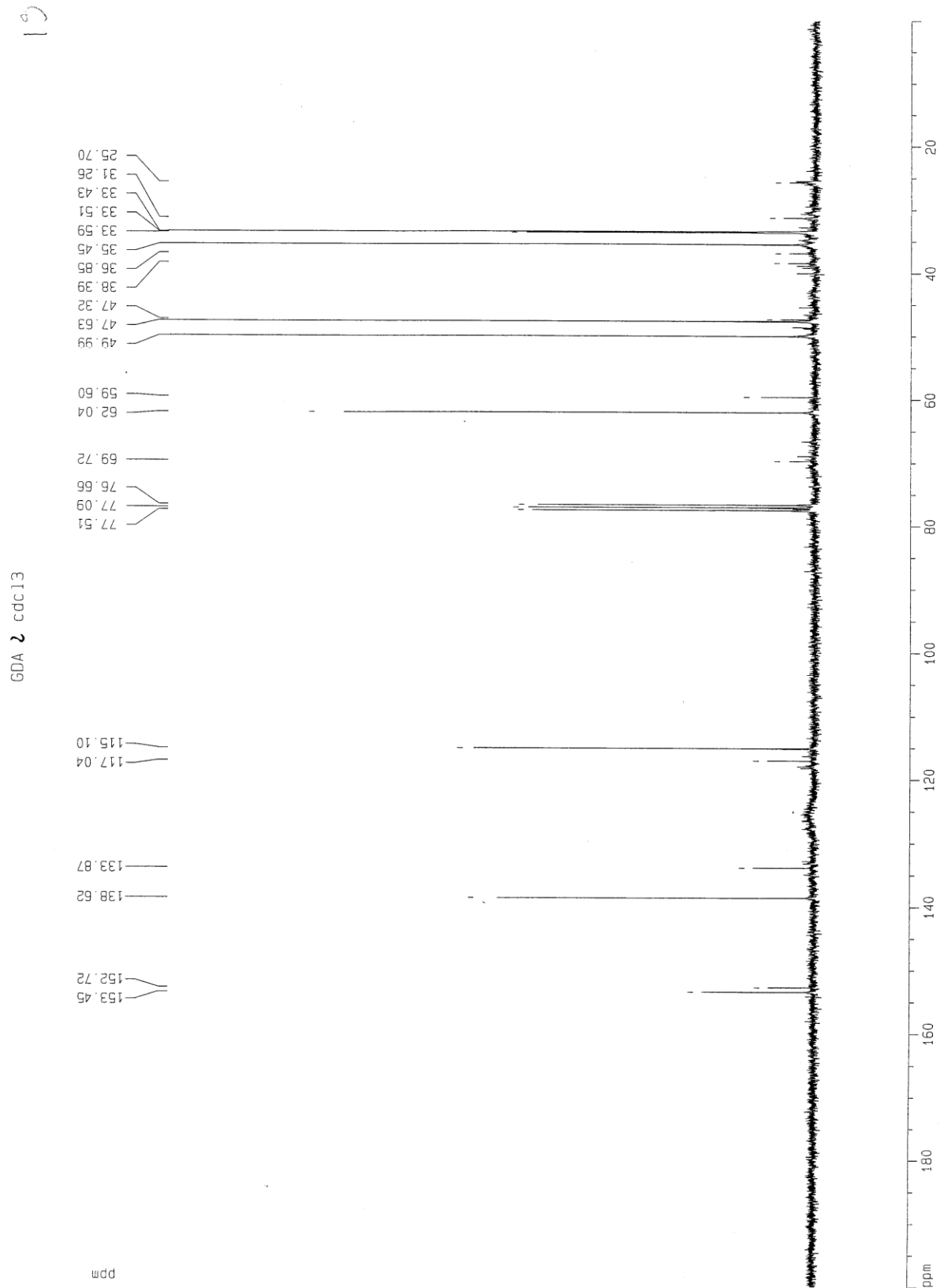


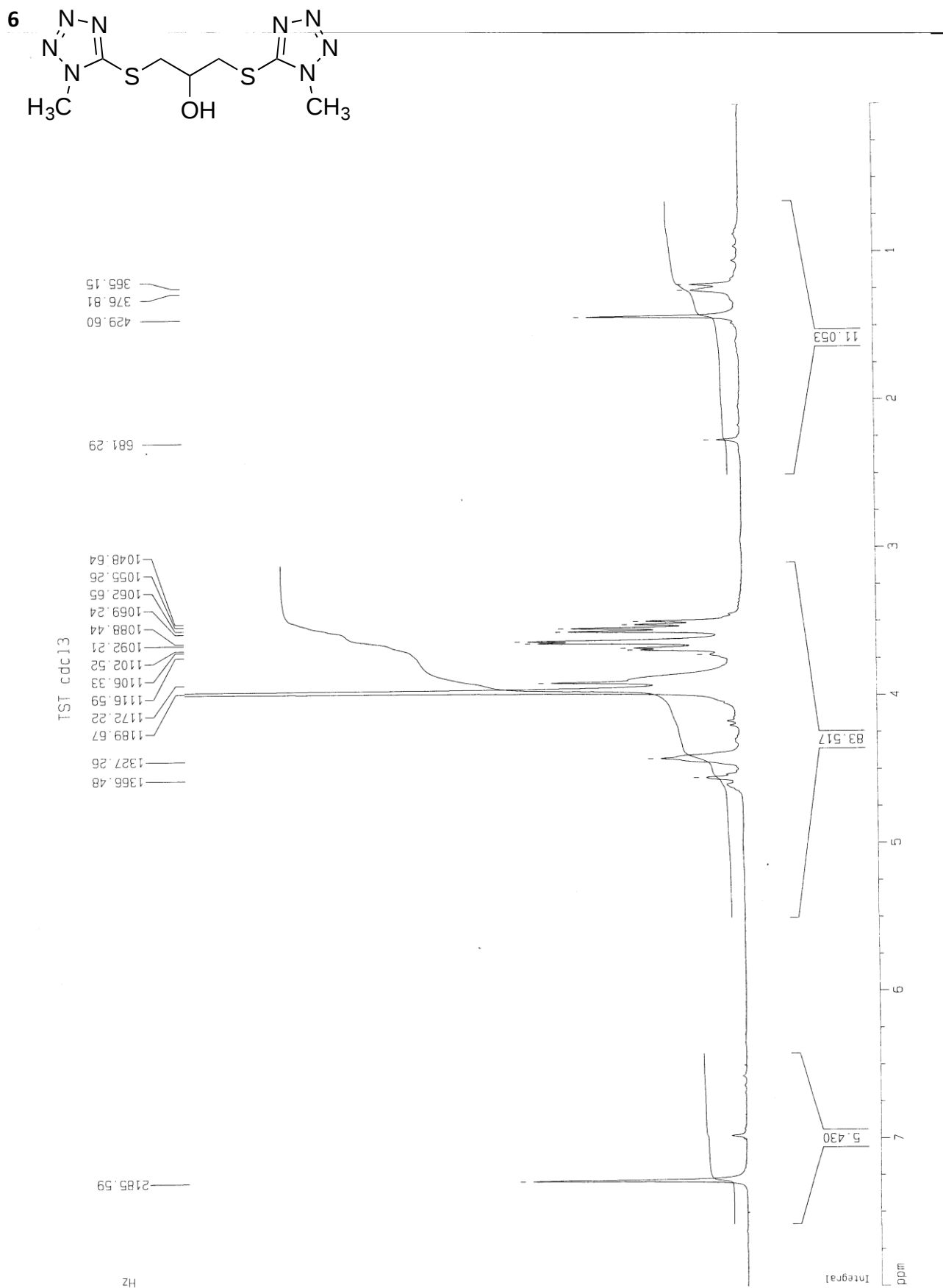


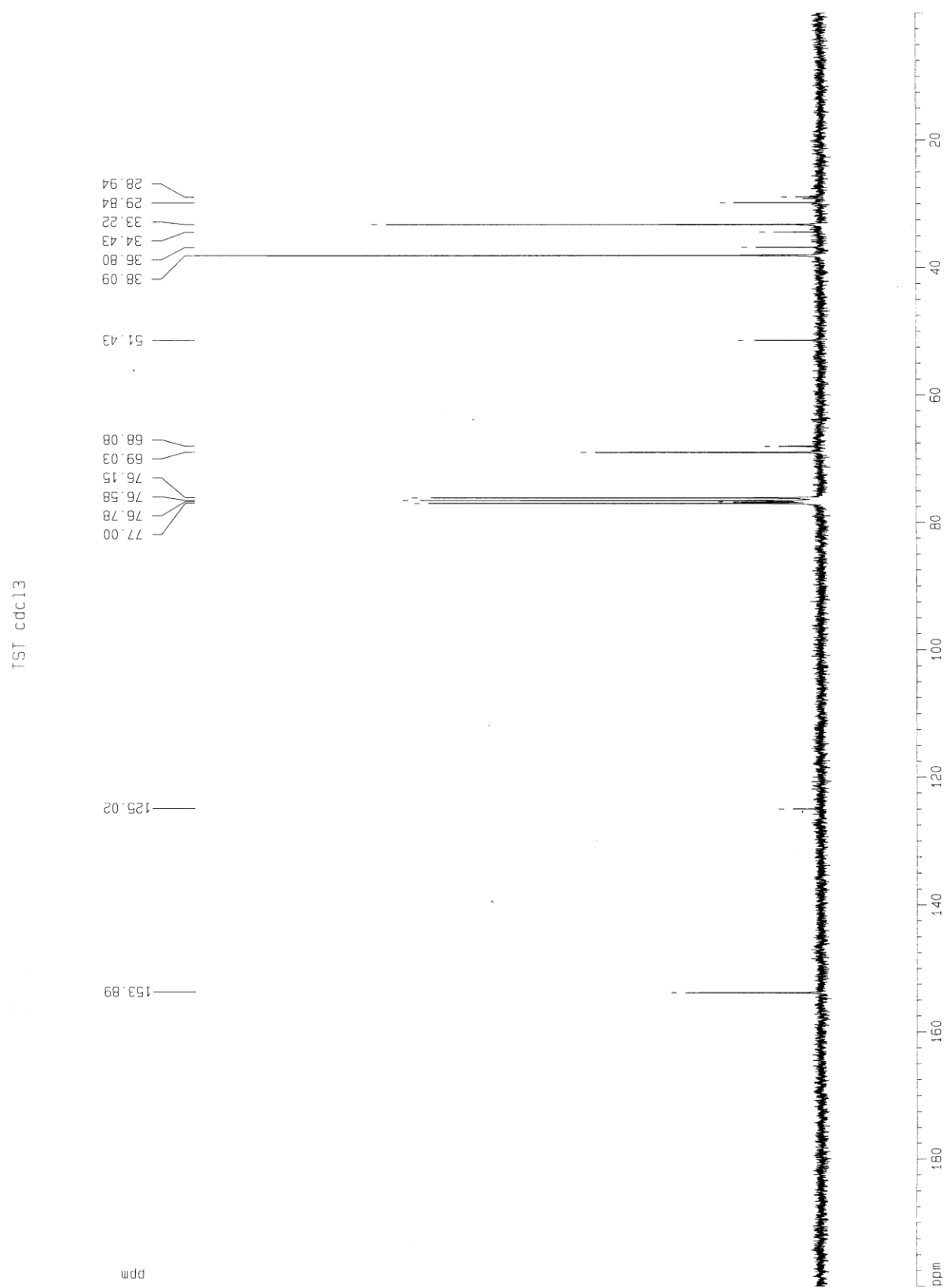


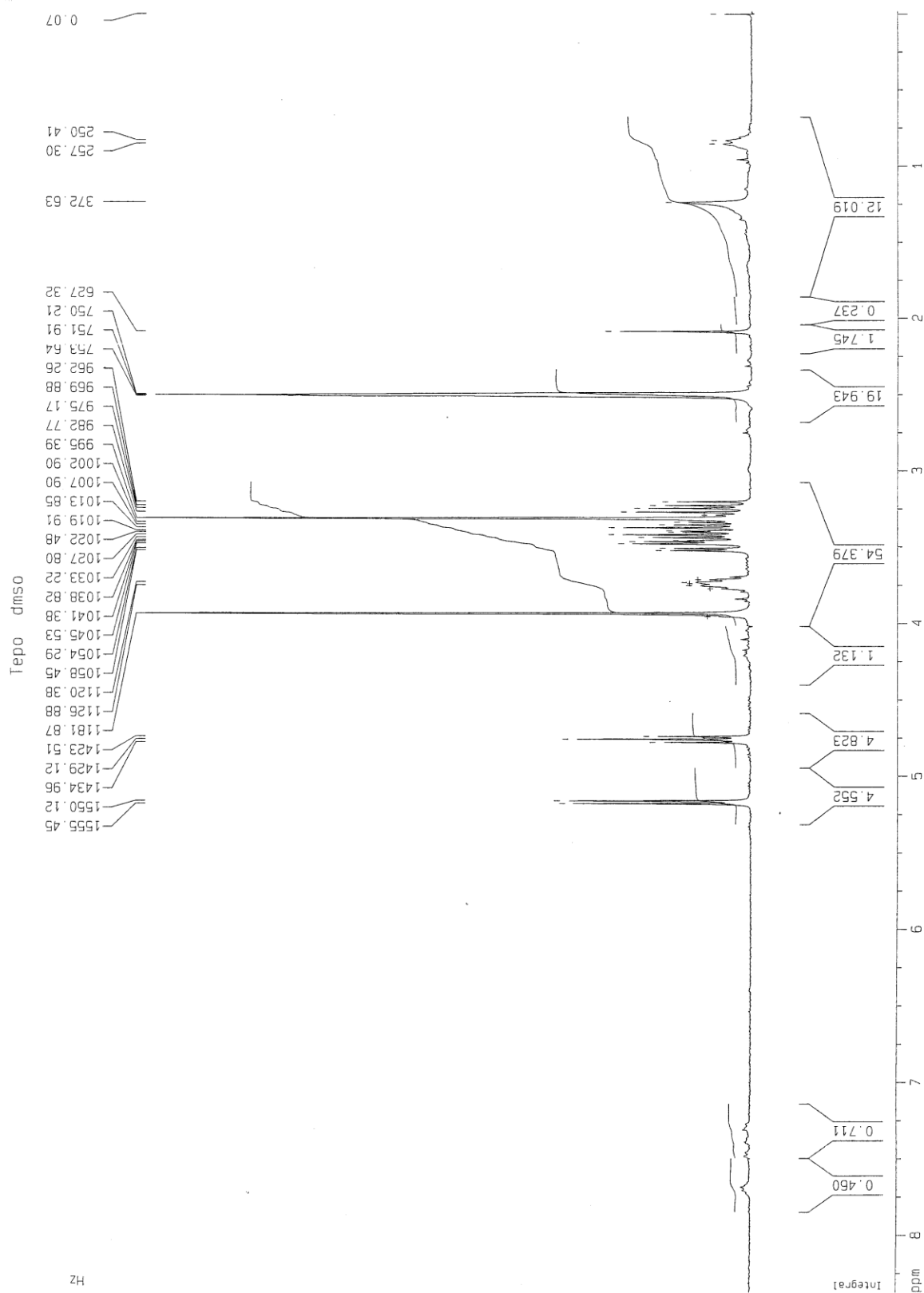
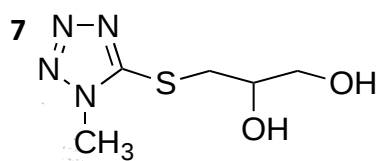


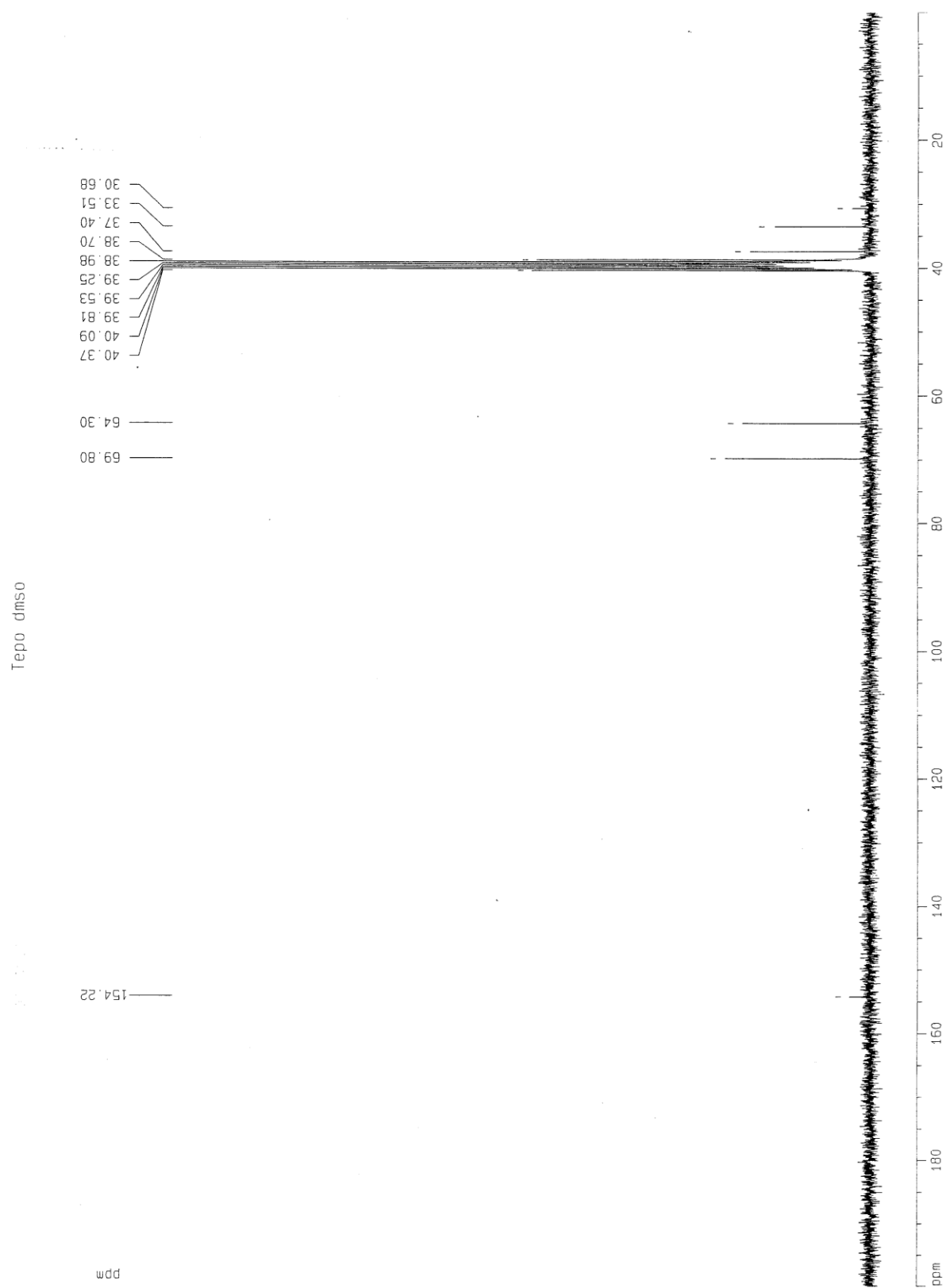


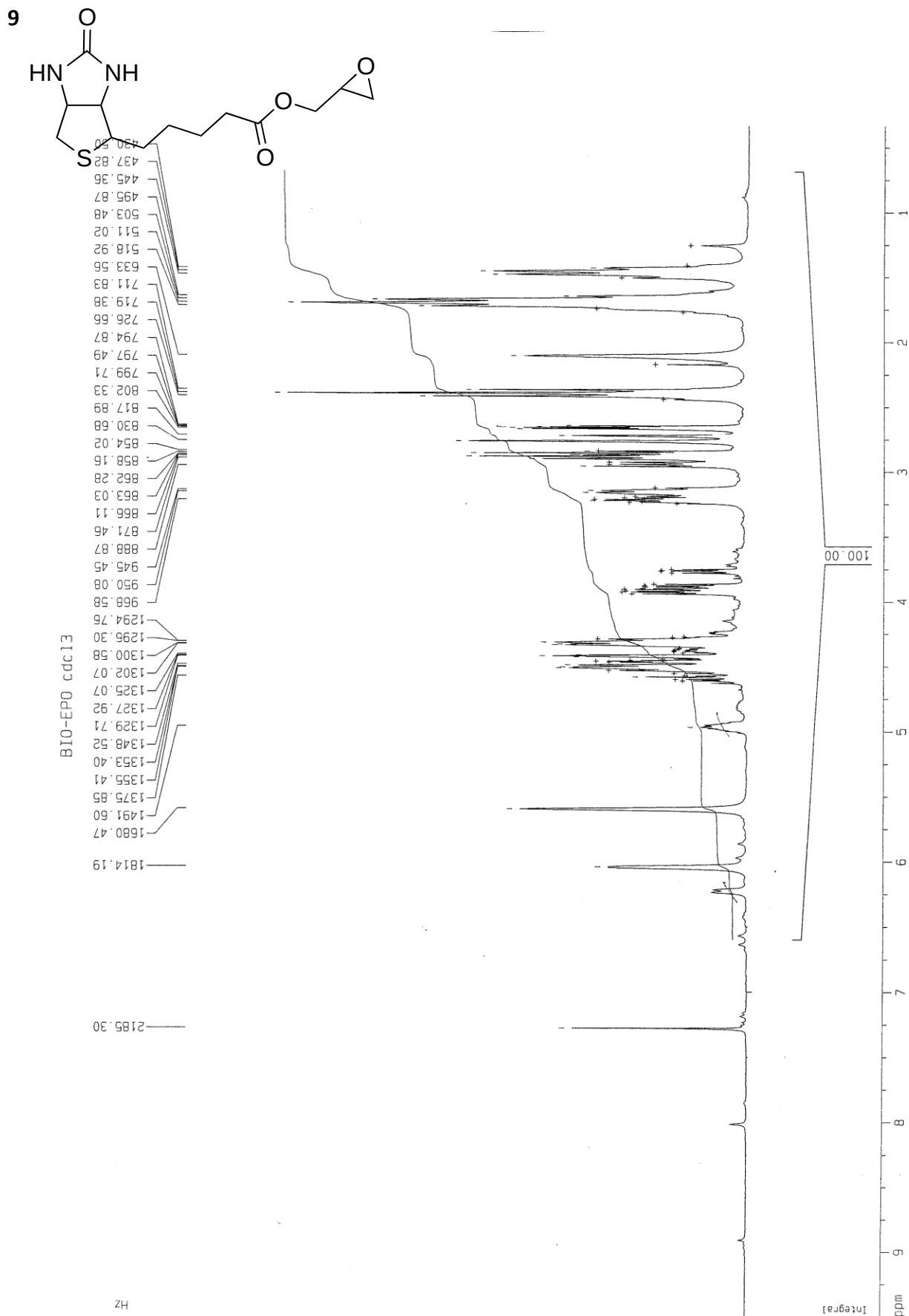


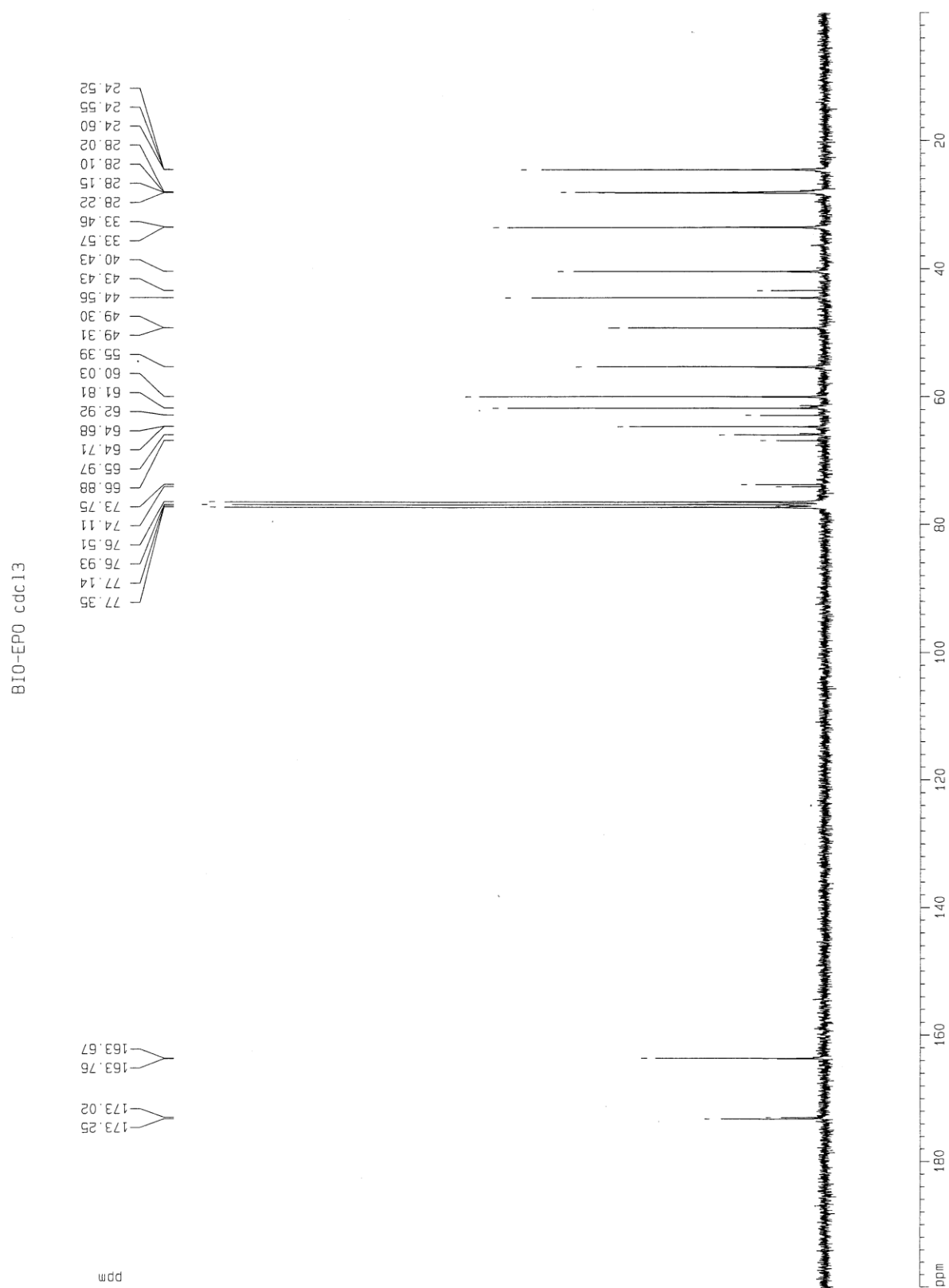




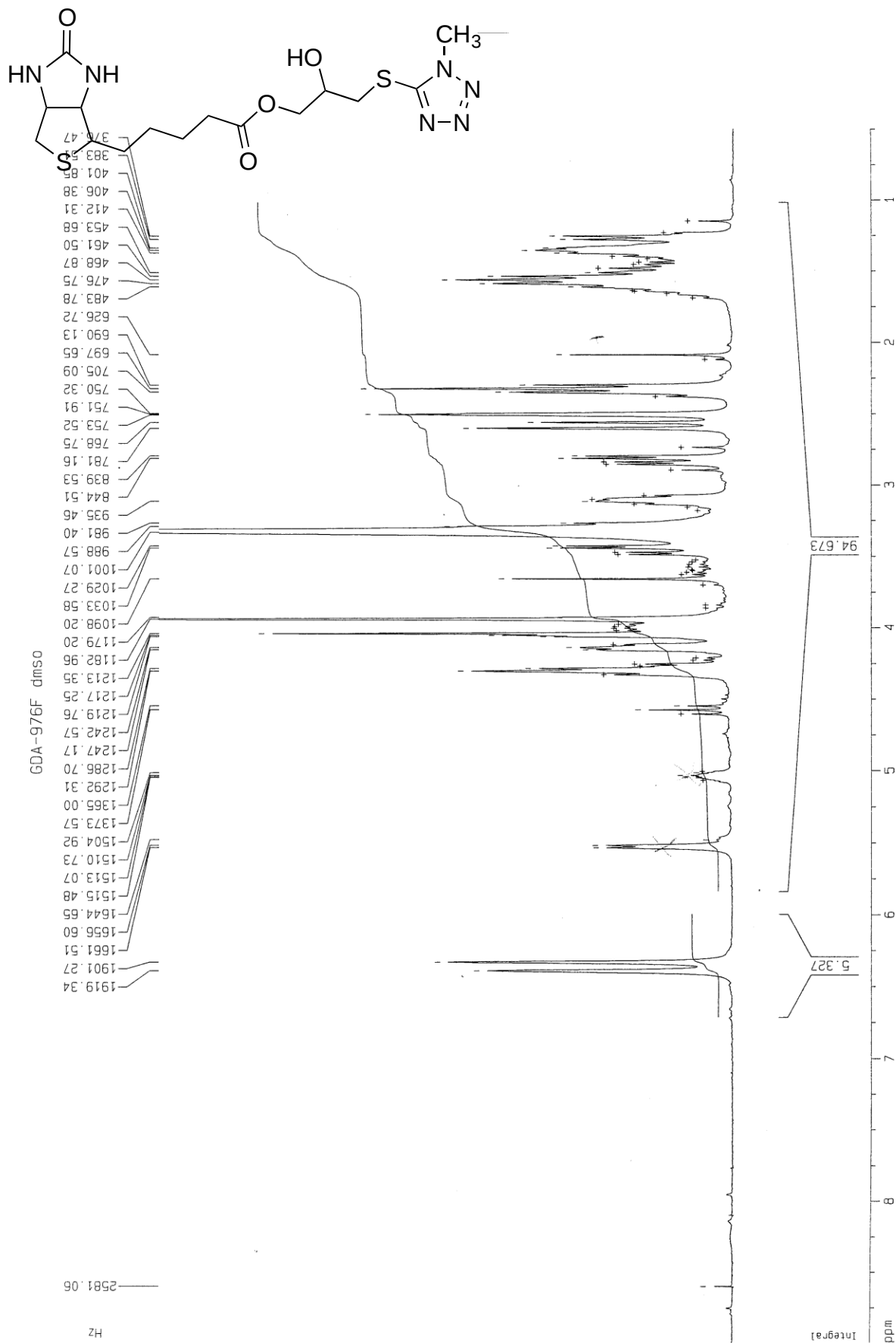


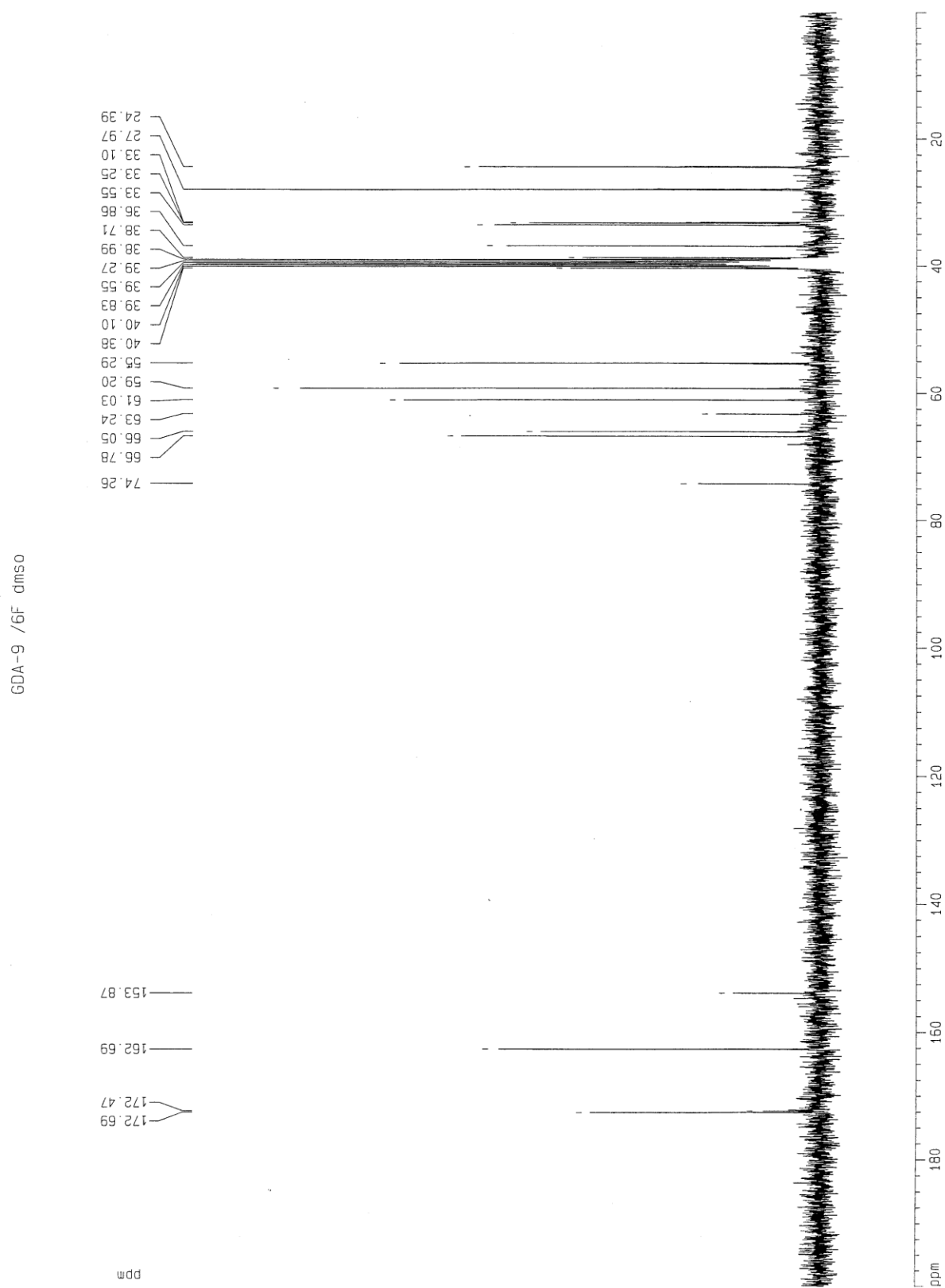


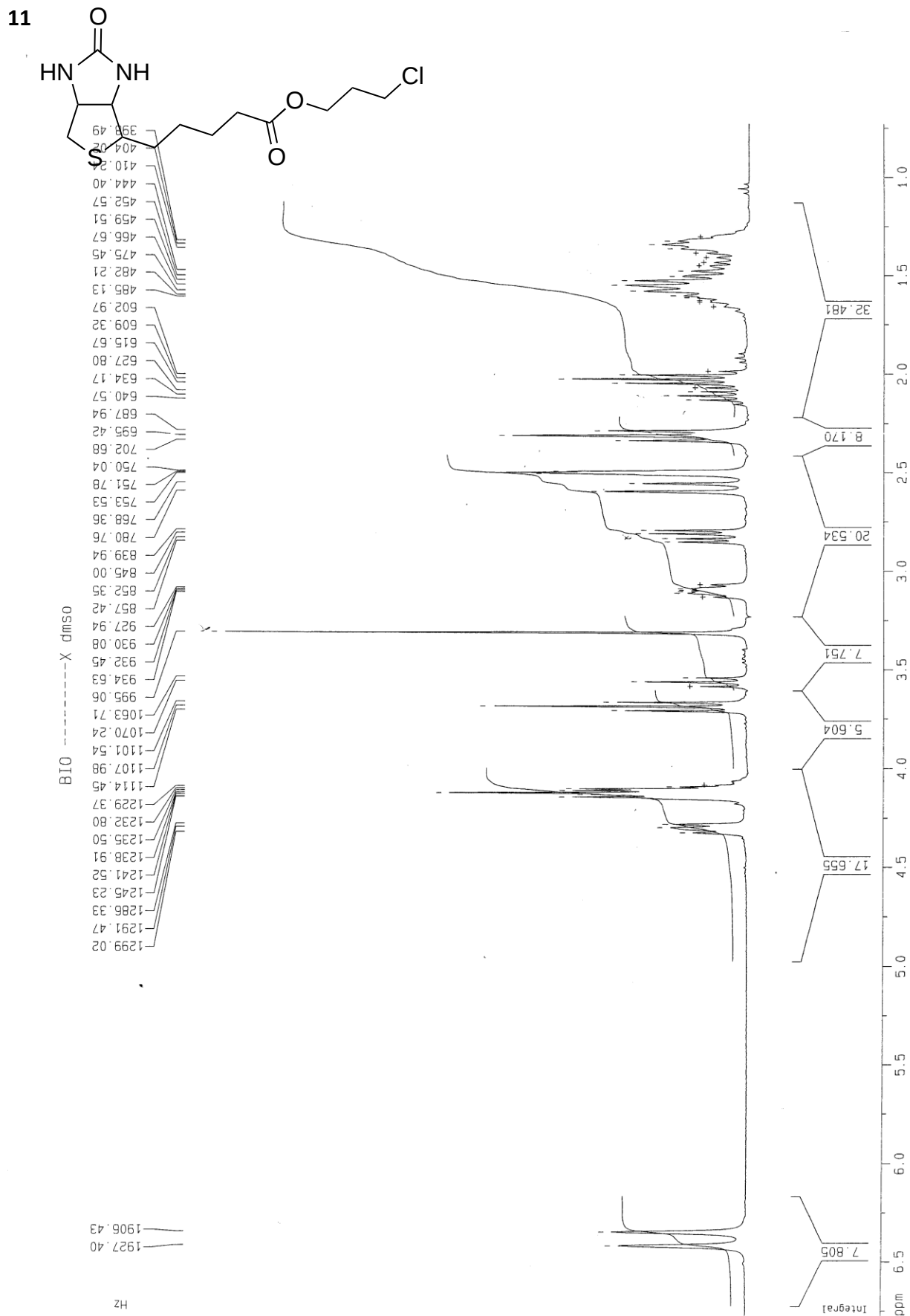


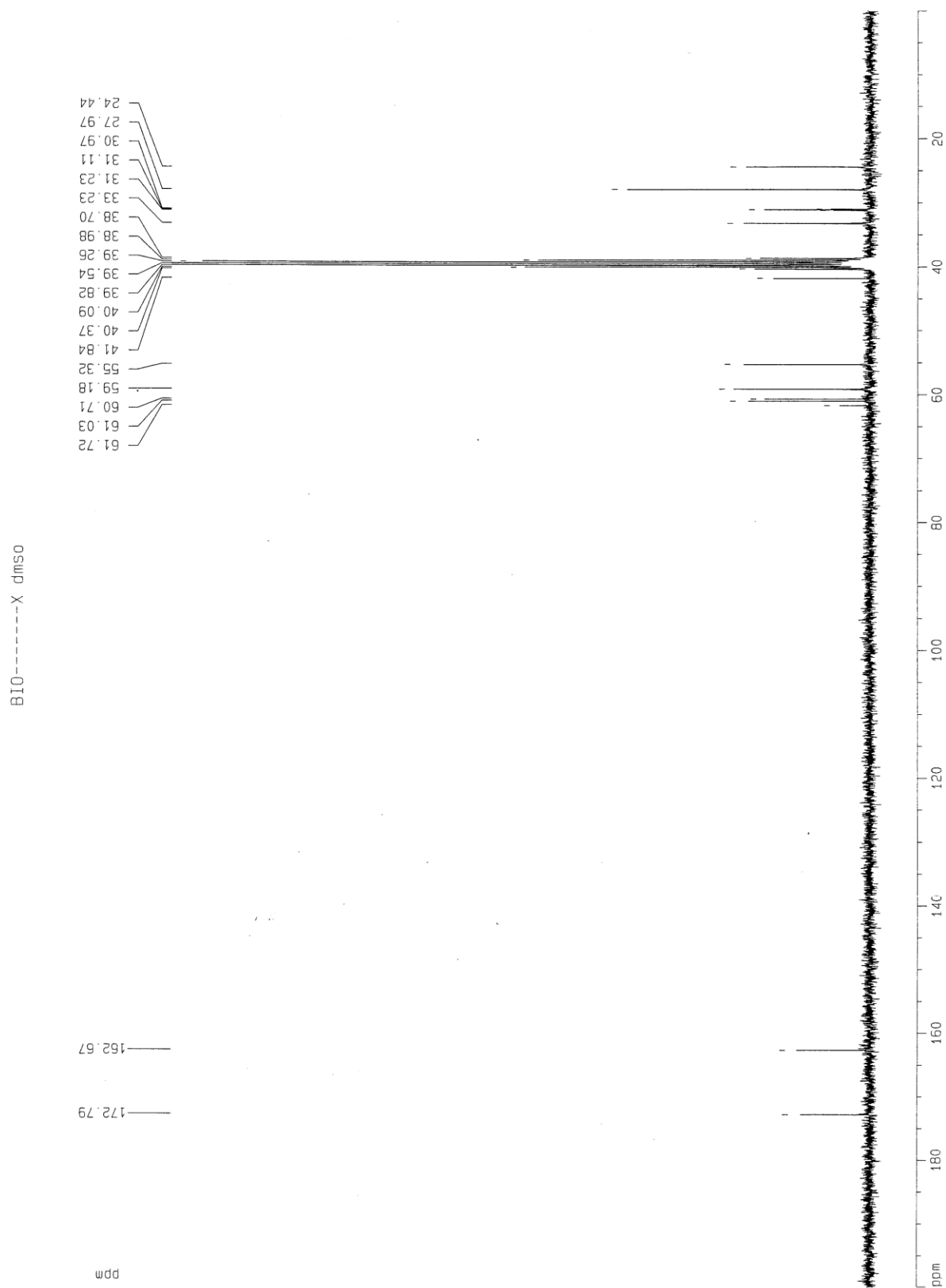


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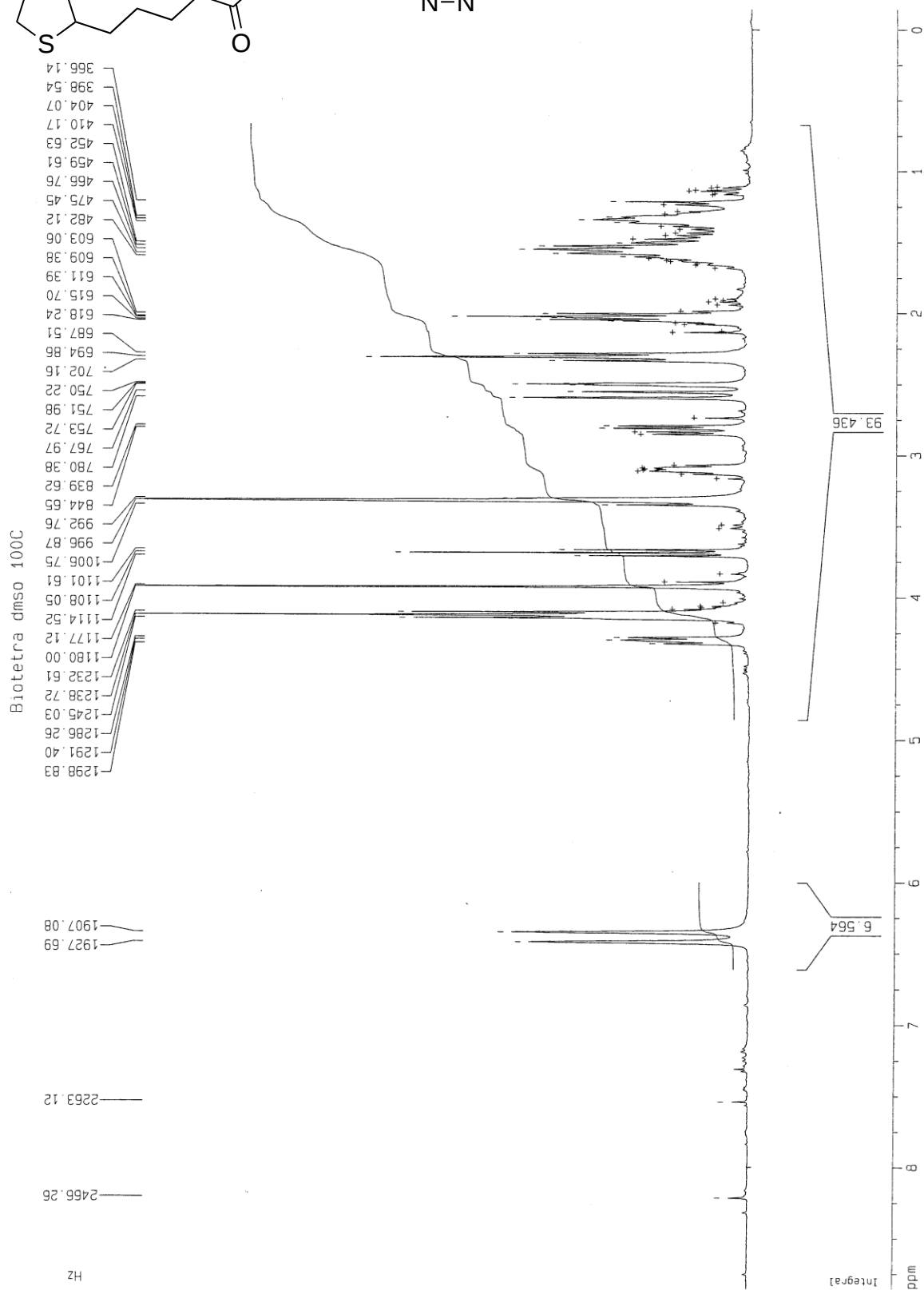
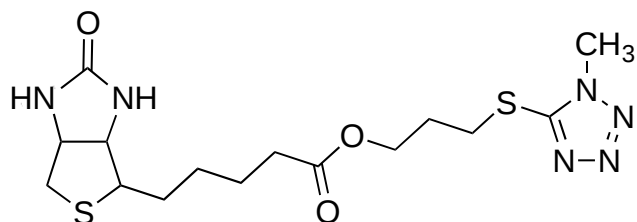


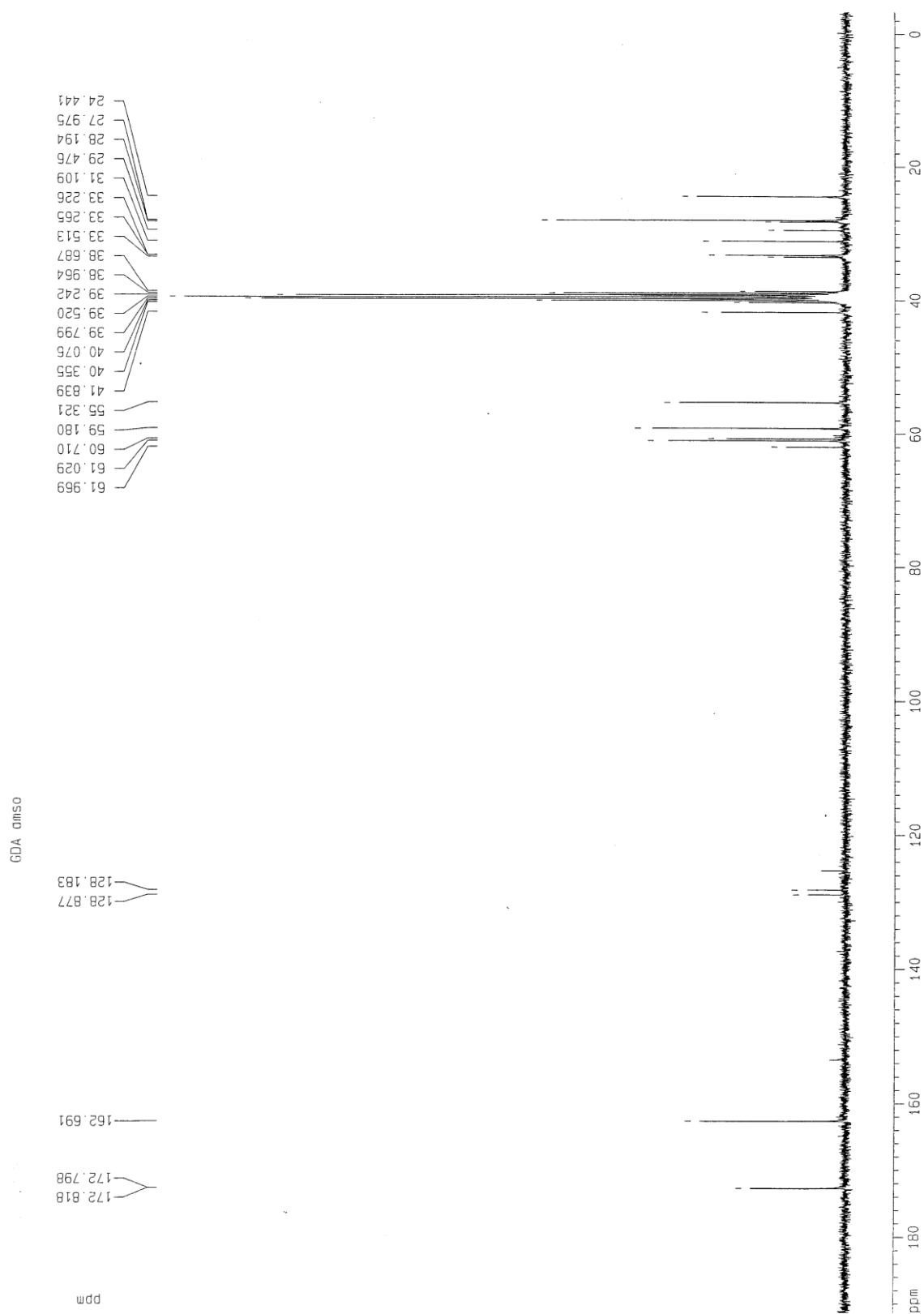


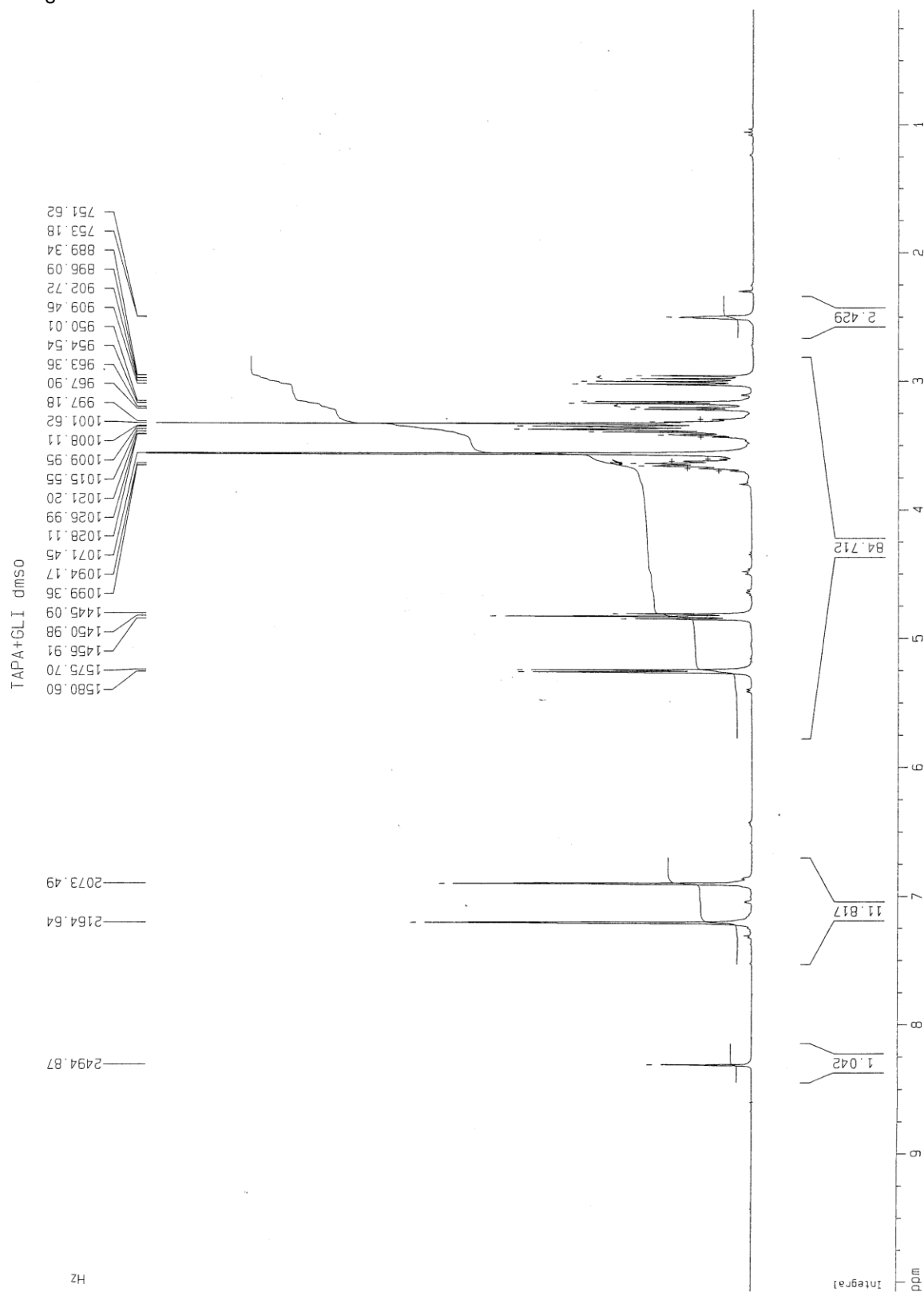
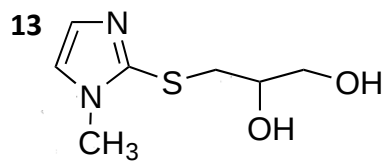


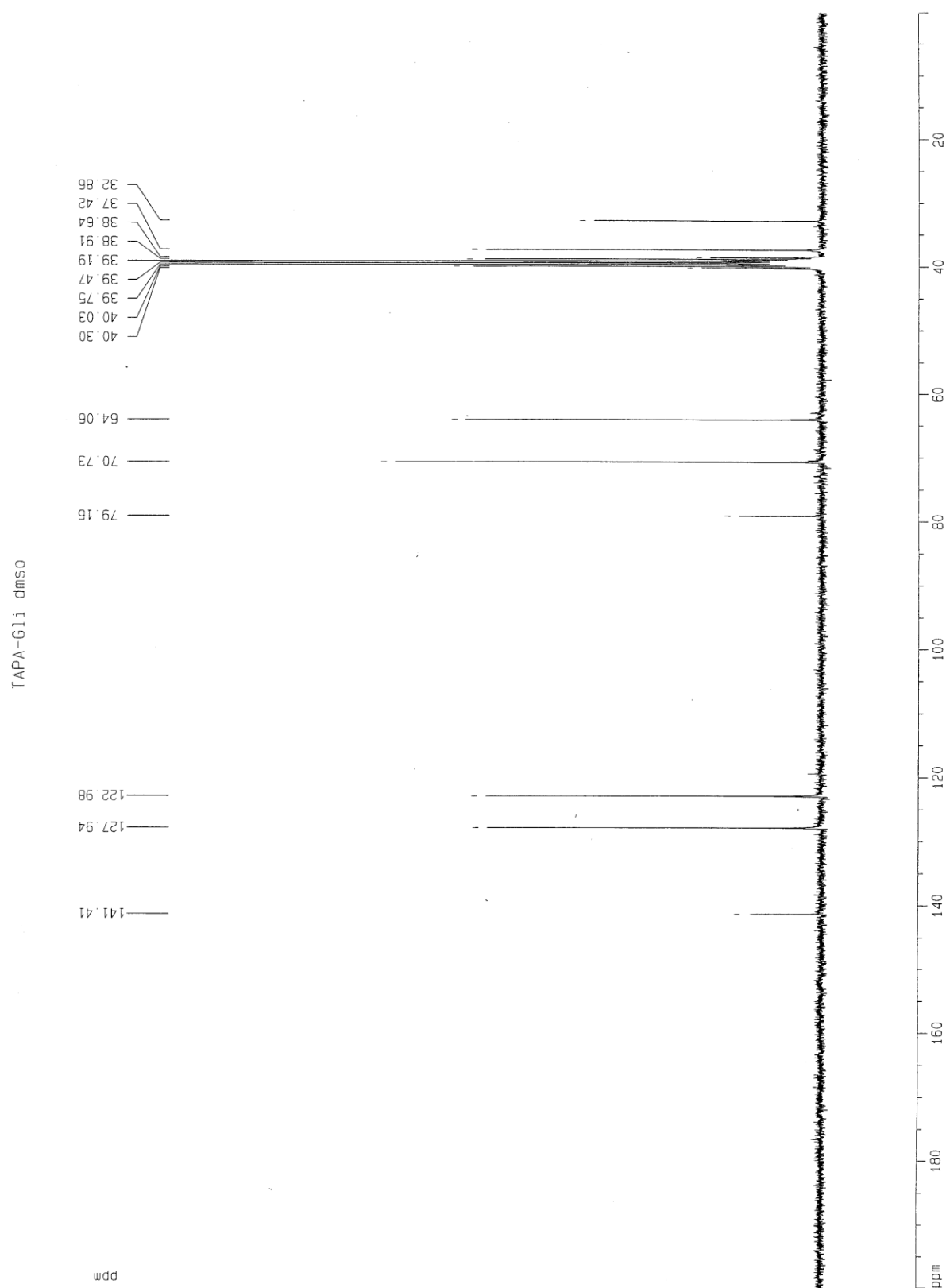


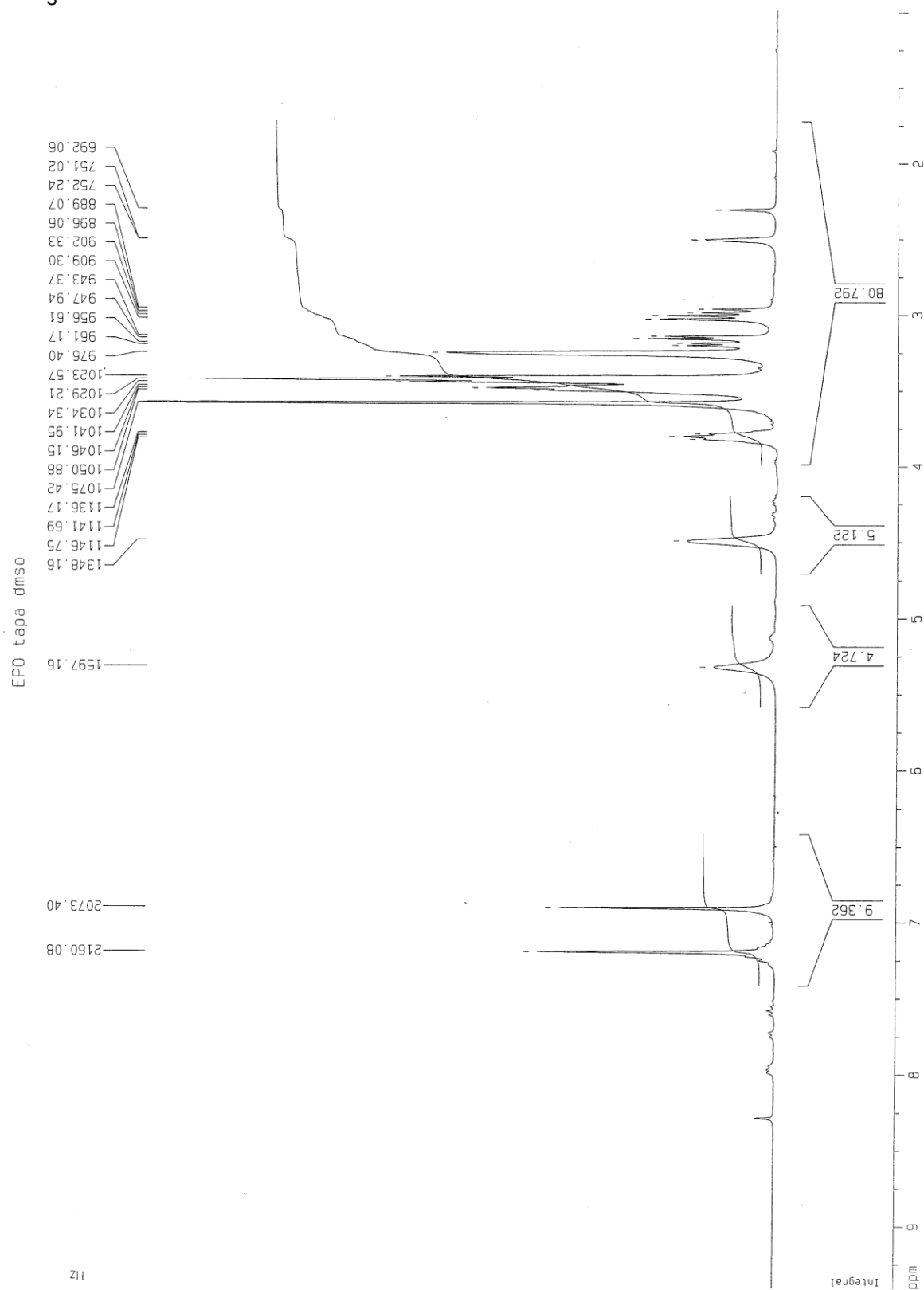
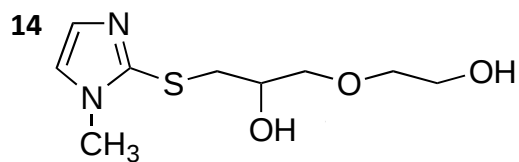
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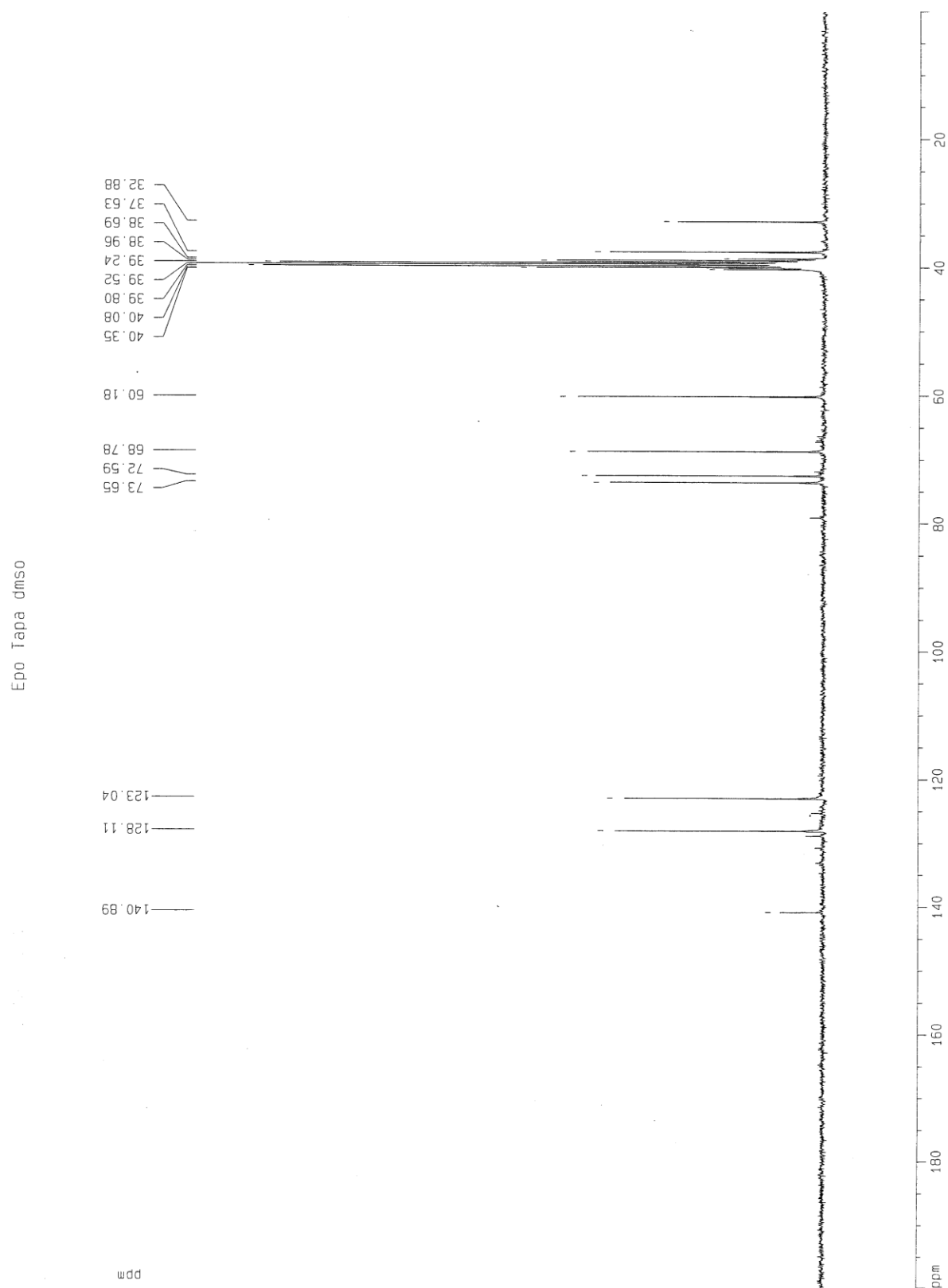


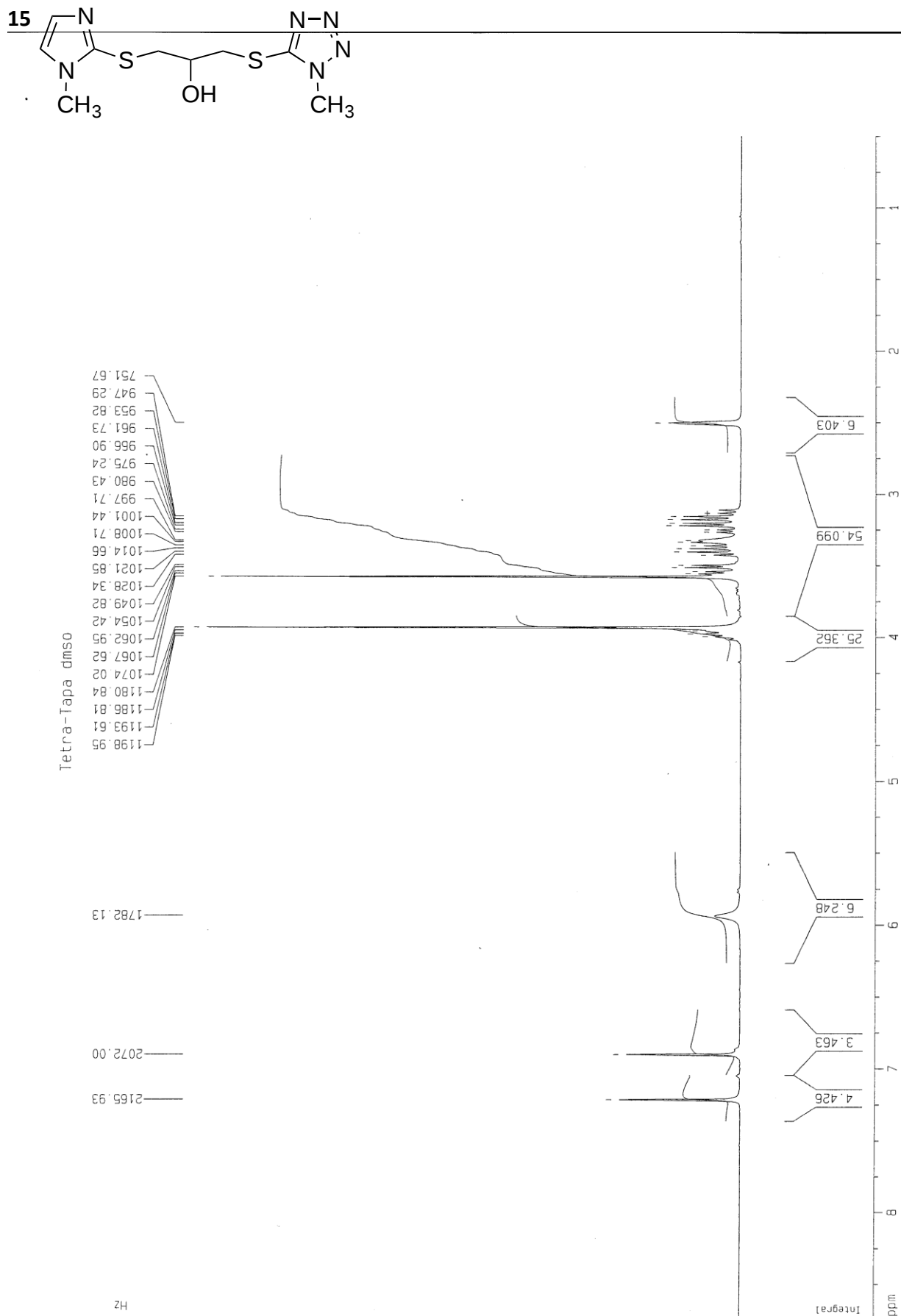


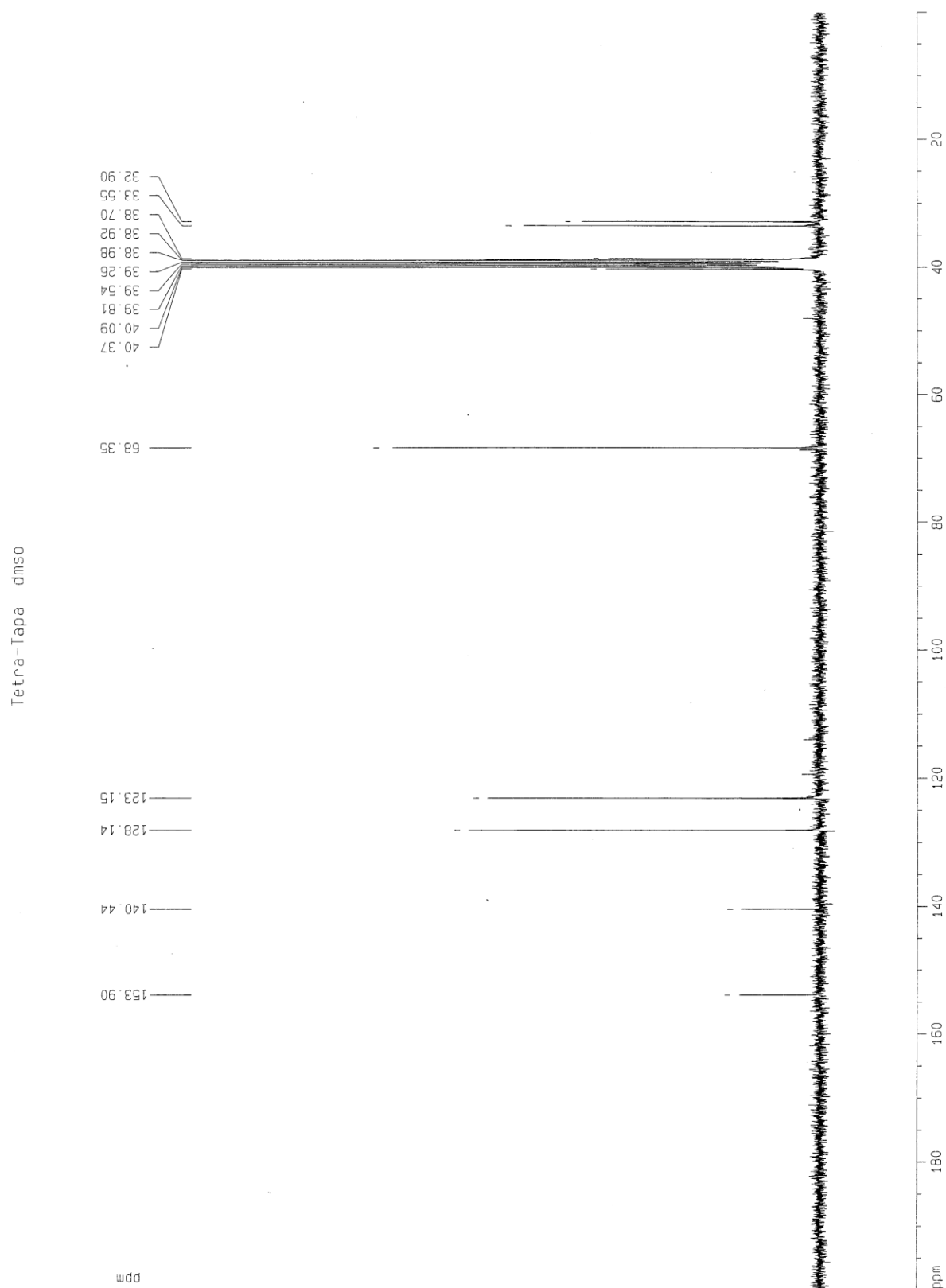












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
